

1720	<p><u>Planning Application Number DA/2017/1240</u> <u>Change of use of part of garage to ancillary residential accommodation to Oxendon Grange (revised scheme to DA/2010/0160)</u> <u>Oxendon Grange, 12 Main Street, Great Oxendon, Northamptonshire, LE16 8NE</u> The Parish Council had no objections to the proposal. This was proposed by Councillor Rumsey and seconded by Councillor D Jones. Unanimous. Councillor C Jones re-joined the meeting at 8.40pm</p>
1721	<p><u>Planning Application Number 17/00037/WASVOC Wormslade</u> <u>Variation of conditions 2 (Scope of Permission), 5 (Operation Limits and Feedstock) and 14 (Catchment Area) of planning consent ref. 15/00090/WASFUL to modify the approved feedstock to incorporate other waste materials.</u> <u>Wormslade Farm, Clipston Road, Kelmarsh.</u> The Odour Plan had been submitted by the Applicant. All of the local comments had been submitted to Northants County Council and its Development Control Committee would determine the variation of conditions at the meeting on 27th February 2018. The Community would need to be well represented. County Councillor Irvine Swift would be attending.</p>
