ABOUT THE PARISH MEETING

All Parish Councils throughout England are required by law to hold an Annual Parish Meeting, which must take place between 1st March and the 1st June (inclusive)

The purpose of the meeting is so that the Parish Council can explain what it has been doing over the last year and it enables the electors to have their say on anything they consider is important to the people of the Parish.

The Annual Parish Meeting is a meeting of all the local government electors for the Parish. It is NOT a Meeting of the Parish Council.

Any registered elector may ask questions of the Parish Council, which will usually be answered by the Chairperson, the Clerk to the Council, or a designated Councillor. An elector may also make suggestions and comment on anything pertinent to the people of Great Oxendon. This will be welcomed as it is the whole purpose of the meeting.

The meeting will last as long as need be – but within reason. It really depends on those present and the number of questions and the discussion that is raised. From experience it is normally over within the hour.
